

# **Delaware HOSA**

## **Uniform Requirements for State Events**

The following official dress code for Delaware HOSA students is required at state HOSA Events. Students representing Delaware at the International Leadership Conference (ILC) must follow the International HOSA dress code (see below).

### **Health Professions**

Students participating in Health Professions events should wear the following:

**Scrub top** with the following:

- V-neck design
- One or two pocket design is acceptable
- Any clothing worn under the scrub top should not be visible (i.e. undershirt)
- A scrub jacket worn over a scrub shirt is acceptable
- School name or logo on scrub top or jacket is not permitted

**Scrub pants** with the following:

- Draw-string or elastic waist
- Pants should reach the top of the shoes, but should not reach the floor

**Footwear:**

- Clean, white or black leather athletic shoes with laces
- Laces should be tied
- Closed toe and fully closed heel

### **CPR Event**

Students participating in the CPR/First Aid competitive event should wear attire appropriate for their career program.

### **EMT Event**

Students participating in the EMT competitive event should wear the official paramedic dress with the following:

- Dark blue or black pants (may be either BDU or dickie-style)
- Polo shirt without school name or logo
- Dark boots

### **Biomedical Laboratories Sciences**

Students participating in Biomedical Health Sciences event should wear the following:

- White Lab Jacket
- White button down blouse or shirt
- Black or navy blue dress pants
- Black or navy blue closed-toe shoes

## **Leadership Events/Teamwork Events/Health Science Events/Recognition Events/Public Health/MRC Partnership**

Students participating in the Leadership events, Teamwork Events, Health Science Events, Recognition Events, Public Health, or MRC Partnership should wear the following:

### *Females:*

- White blouse should be either a white shell or button down with collar (no polo shirts)
- Black or navy blue dress pants should reach the top of the shoes, but should not reach the floor
- Black or navy blue closed-toe shoes, no more than 2" heel
- Nude, black or navy blue nylon stockings without pattern (optional)

### *Males:*

- White, long-sleeve button down shirt with collar (no polo shirts)
- Solid navy blue, black or maroon necktie
- Black or navy blue dress shoes
- Black or navy blue socks
- Black or navy blue dress pants

## **Rare and Chronic Disease Display Event**

Students participating in the Rare and Chronic Disease Display Event should wear the official HOSA uniform or business attire, which includes the following:

### *1. Females:*

- Navy blue or black blazer
- White blouse should be either a white shell or button down with collar
- Navy blue or black dress pants should reach the top of the shoes, but should not reach the floor
- Black or navy blue closed-toe shoes, no more than 2" heel
- Nude, black or navy blue nylon stockings without pattern (optional)

### *2. Males:*

- Navy blue or black blazer
- White, long-sleeve button down shirt with collar
- Solid navy blue, black or maroon necktie
- Black dress shoes
- Black or navy blue socks
- Navy blue or black dress pants
